<b>Shén Nóng</b>	神农	Mythical Chinese ruler from pre-history. Known by many names.
<b>Qīng dynasty</b>	清朝	China's final imperial dynasty. Ran from 1644-1911
<b>yuántóu</b>	源头	fountainhead, source, headwater
<b>Ānhuī</b>	安徽	Province in Central China west of Zhejiang
<b>Zhèjiāng</b>	浙江	Coastal province in China, and a rich one at that
<b>Fújiàn</b>	福建	Another coastal province in China, south of Zhejiang
<b>Jiāqìng emperor</b>	嘉庆帝	Qing Emperor from 1796-1820
<b>Dàoguāng</b>	道光帝	Qing Emperor from 1821-1850
<b>Xiánfēng</b>	咸丰帝	Qing Emperor from 1851-1861
<b>Guǎngdōng</b>	广东	Coastal province in southern China
<b>Guāngcǎi</b>	光彩	Means lustre, splendour, radiance. A kind of porcelain ware famous in the Guangzhou area for its designs
<b>Wǔyí Mountains</b>	武夷山	Mountains in northern Fujian famous for Buddhist Temples and tea
<b>Treaty of Nánjīng</b>	南京条约	Treaty signed in August 1842 that ended the First Opium War.
<b>Lín Zéxú</b>	林则徐	Qing era official and Viceroy who lived 1785-1850. Considered a national hero for standing up to the Western powers in the 1830's
<b>Yángzǐ</b>	扬子江	The Yangtze River, longest river in China
<b>Níngbō</b>	宁波	Major city just south of Shanghai. An economic powerhouse loaded with history
